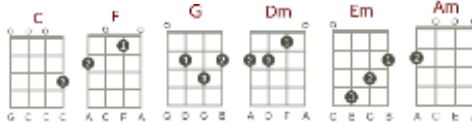


# A THING CALLED LOVE
