'bout a [F] quarter to four,

[Bb] Dinner in the [G7] diner, [F] nothing could be [D7] finer,

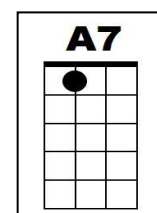
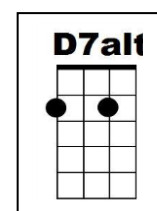
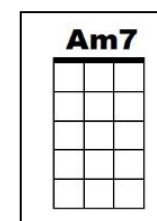
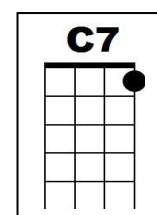
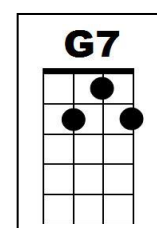
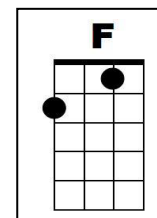
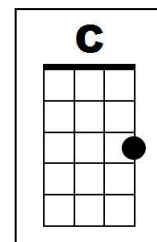
Than to [G7] have your ham and eggs in [C7] Carolina.
