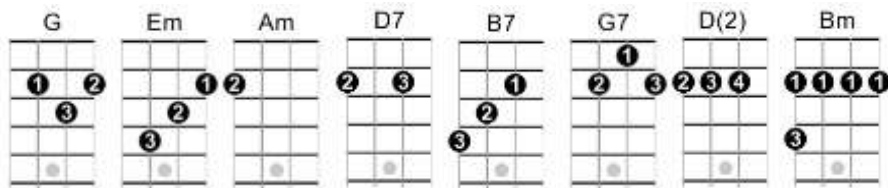


Have Yourself A Merry Little Christmas — Martin & Blane

Voice starts on low G

G Have your**Em**self a **Am** merry little **D7** Christmas,

G let your **Em** heart be **Am** light, **D7**

G Next year **Em** all our **Am** troubles will be **D7**out of **G** sight. **Em Am D7**

G Have your**Em**self a **Am** merry little **D7** Christmas, **G** make the **Em** yuletide **Am** gay, **D7**

G Next year **Em** all our **Am** troubles will be **B7** miles a**Em**way. **Em G7 G7**

Middle 8

Em Once a**Em**gain as in **D** olden days,**D** .. happy **Am** golden days**D7** .. of **G** yore **G**

Em Faithful **Em** friends who are **Bm** dear to us,

Bm ...shall be **D** near to us **Am**once **D** more **D7**

G Someday **Em** soon we **Am** all will be to**D7**gether, **G** if the **Em** fates al**Am**low **D7**

G Until **Em** then we'll **Am** have to muddle **D** through some **Em** how. **Em G7**

G7....So **C** have your **C** self a **Am** merry little **D7** Christmas **G** now.

Repeat from start to end, slowing down on last line.
