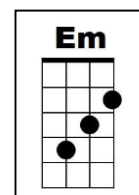
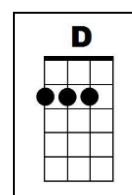
Now I've [G] heard there is a [Em] list of chords

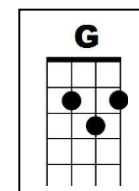
