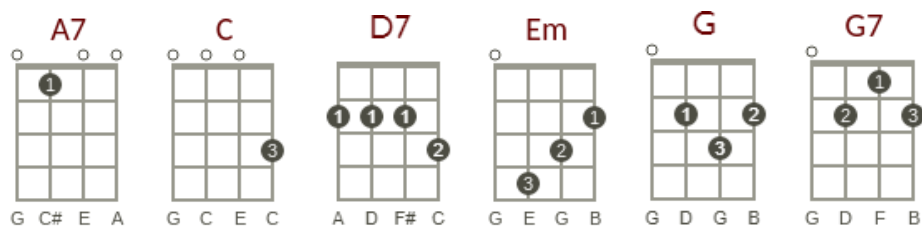


Never Smile At A Crocodile

Verse 2:

[G] Never smile at a [G] crocodile

 Never [C] run, walk a [G] way, say good [C] night, not good [G] day
 Clear the [C] aisle and never [G] smile at Mister [G!] Croc [D7!] o [G!] dile

[C] You may very [G7] well be well bred
 [C] Lots of eti [G7] quette in your head
 [C] Bur there's always [G] some special [C] case I will [G] place
 To for [D7] get eti [G!] quette
 For [D7!] instance
