
RUNNING BEAR

INTRODUCTION

Ukes Strum (with emphasis on first beat) [G] Dddd Dddd Dddd until Sid starts chant (same rhythm) for the next line ...

VERSE 1 Strum Dddd

[G] On the BANK of the River stood Running [C] BEAR young Indian [G] BRAVE On the OTHer side of the River stood his [A7] LOVEly Indian [D]MAID Little [G] WHITE Dove was a- HER name such a [C] LOVEly sight to [G] SEE But their TRIBES fought with each OTHer so their [D]LOVE could never [G] BE DuDu Du

CHORUS Keep Rhythm DuDu

[G] Running [C] BEAR loved Little [G] WHITE Dove with a [D7] LOVE big as the [G] SKY Running [C] BEAR loved Little [G] WHITE Dove with a [D7]LOVEthat couldn't [G] DIE Dddd

VERSE 2 Keep Rhythm Dddd continuous from last chord of chorus

[G] He couldn't SWIM the raging RIver cause the [C] RIver was too [G] WIDE He couldn't REACH Little WHITE Dove waiting [A7] ON the other [D] SIDE In the [G] MOONlight he could SEE her throwing [C] KISSes 'cross the [G]WAVES Her little HEART was beating FASTer waiting [D] FOR her Indian[G] BRAVE DuDu Du

CHORUS

VERSE 3 Keep Rhythm Dddd continuous from last chord of chorus

[G] Running BEAR dove in the WAter little [C] WHITE Dove did the [G] SAME and they SWAM out to each PTHer through the [A7] SWIRling stream they [D] CAME As their [G] HANDStouched and theirLIPS met the raging [C] RIver pulled them [G] DOWN Now they'll ALways be to GEther in that [D] HAppy hunting [G] GROUND DuDu Du

Keep strumming: Dddd Dddd until SID comes in with
