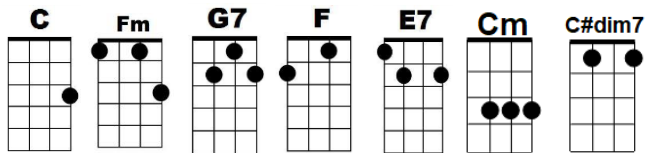


That's Amore

(echo: that's amore)

(echo: that's amore)

Bells will **[C] ring**, ting-a-ling-a-ling, ting-a-ling-a-ling, and you'll sing "Vita **[G7] bel-la**".

(echo: vita bella)

Hearts will **[G7]play** tippy tippy tay, tippy tippy **tay**, like a gay tar-an- **[C]-tel-la.**

(echo: lucky fella)

When the **[C] stars** make you drool just like **pasta** fazool, that's a- **[G7]mor-e.**

(echo: that's amore)

When you **[G7] dance** down the street with a cloud at your feet,

you're in **[E7] love. [C#dim7]** (echo: you're in love)

When you **[F] walk** in a dream, but you **know** you're not dreaming, Sig- **[C]-nor-e,**

(echo: signore)

Scusa **[G7]me**, but you see, back in **old** Napoli, that's a- **[C]-mor-e!**

(echo : amore, amore)
